Would you please forward this letter to relevant Scottish Ministers?

I / we call on the Scottish Ministers who will decide on the Beauly-Denny power line proposals to recognise:

- that sub-sea cables, or partial undergrounding, could both offer better alternatives to the overland, all-overhead power line proposed;
- that a viable underground route for the Stirling area was identified during the Public Inquiry;
- that using either alternative would avoid all of the many negative impacts that the overhead line would create in the Stirling area;
- that underground cables are increasingly being required in many parts of Europe, to avoid health and environmental impacts;
- that all the costs of an upgrade would be shared between all electricity consumers in the UK; and
- that there is very widespread concern about the Beauly-Denny proposals throughout the Stirling area.

Scotland deserves the least damaging solution to this issue!
